The Downtown Schenectady Improvement Corporation (DSIC) and City of Schenectady are partnering for a second year to bring you the **Hometown Heroes Banner Program**. This banner program is designed to proudly recognize active duty and veteran servicepersons from the City. Each banner will honor a specific City of Schenectady serviceperson and will include his or her name, branch of service, and photo. Banners will be displayed on street lamps in Downtown Schenectady along State Street (from Veterans Park to South Church Street) and around City Hall from mid-May until mid-November.

To qualify, honorees must meet the following requirements:

- Born in Schenectady, graduated from Schenectady City School District, a current City resident, or a City property owner.
- Serving on active duty in the United States Armed Forces or National Guard, or veterans who have served in the United States Armed Forces or National Guard and have been honorably discharged.

Banners may be sponsored by individuals or organizations at a cost of **\$300 per banner**. If you would like to sponsor a banner but don't know of a serviceperson who meets the requirements stated, we can help you identify someone for your banner/banners. There are a limited number of locations; all sponsorships will be honored on a first come, first served basis.

For your financial support, you will receive the following benefits per banner:

- Production of one (1) 63" x 18" double-sided digital custom vinyl banner.
- Highly visible banner placement either around City Hall or along State Street.
- An 8x10 photo of your sponsored banner.
- At the completion of the 2016 program, the banner will be permanently removed and presented to you at a closing reception.

Downtown Schenectady has become a prime Capital Region destination for dining, shopping, entertainment, events, and business. These banners will be located in the heart of downtown and will be seen by countless workers, residents, visitors, and investors.
