Gail has also contacted Manpower to see about getting some additional help for outside maintenance and cleaning.

We continue to work with businesses for re-opening. Mayor McCarthy is waiving the \$250 permit fee for outdoor cafes and will entertain individual business requests for increased outdoor space. Metroplex has agreed to work with us on a plan to dedicate parking spots around downtown as designated pick-up locations for restaurants and other businesses.

At Jim's request, Heather, Ray and Chris will get together to discuss possible flexibility with staff vacation time in 2020 due to COVID-19 restrictions.

3) Other – Richard suggested that we approach Transfinder about mapping out an optimized watering route for the flower baskets. Jim will follow up with them.
