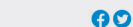

# GETTING TO DOWNTOWN SCHENECTADY



## BY CAR

Downtown Schenectady is conveniently located along I-890, just off the New York State Thruway (I-90), and is just a short drive from New York City, Boston and Montreal.

- **From South & East:** Take NYS Thruway to Exit 25. Follow I-890 west to Exit 5 (Broadway – right at end of ramp), Exit 4C (Scotia – straight ahead or right onto Route 5 at end of ramp) or Exit 4B (Erie Boulevard – Bear left around curve to Erie Boulevard).
- **From West:** Take NYS Thruway to Exit 26. Follow I-890 east to Exit 4B (Erie Boulevard) or Exit 5 (Broadway – left at end of ramp).
- **From North:** Take I-87 to Exit 6 (Route 7 west). Turn right onto Route 7 west and follow for 9 miles to I-890 west. Follow I-890 west to Exit 5 (Broadway – right at end of ramp), Exit 4C (Scotia – straight ahead or right onto Route 5 at end of ramp) or Exit 4B (Erie Boulevard – Bear left around curve to Erie Boulevard)

## GETTING AROUND

### Gateway Mobility Center Coming Summer 2023



The new **Gateway Mobility Center** – adjacent to Gateway Plaza on Lower State Street – includes access to ten transit routes including the Capital District Transportation Authority's (CDTA) **Bus Plus Red Line BRT** and CDTA's other mobility services:

- **DRIVE** electric car share
- **CDPHP Cycle!** bike share
- **SCOOT** e-scooter share

Other amenities include new sidewalks with snow and ice melt systems, upgraded traffic signals, a bus-only turn off, and a new enclosed waiting area. The project also includes improvements to Gateway Plaza, with new lighting, seating, and landscaping, as well as adjacent parking spaces and EV charging stations.

CDPHP Cycle! is a bike-share program offering the community a healthy and affordable mode of transportation. The program provides hundreds of bikes distributed among bike stations around the Capital Region, including Downtown Schenectady Presented by CDPHP and CDTA.

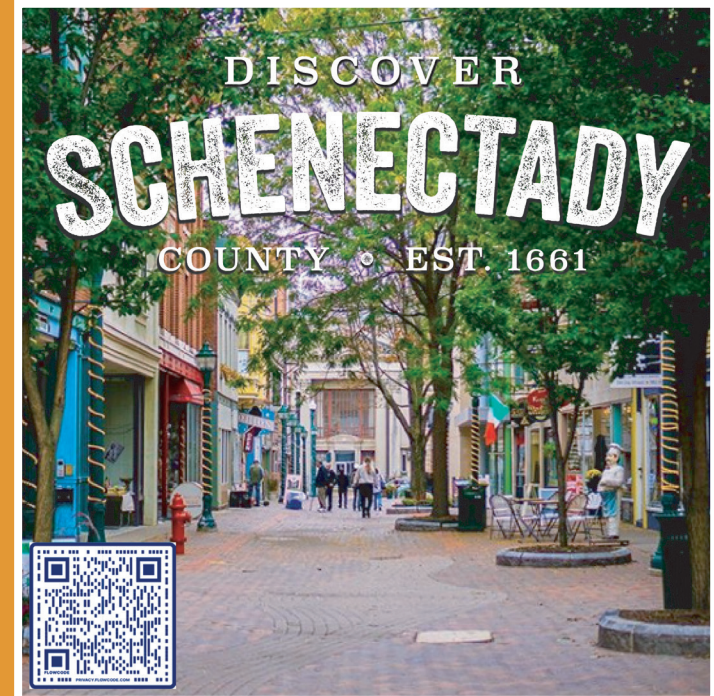

Downtown Schenectady offers two convenient ways to pay for parking.

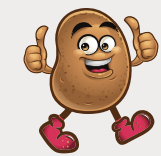

- **Passport Parking App**
  - Download the free Passport Parking app for your Apple or Android smartphone and connect to a personal payment method
  - Enter your zone number and confirm payment
  - Extend your parking session via smartphone
  - Accepted at all Park Schenectady surface lots and on-street parking (not available in the Parking Garage; credit card payments here only)
- **Pay-by-Plate Parking Meters**
  - Meters accept coins, cash (\$1 and \$5 bills), and credit cards
  - Visitors will be prompted to enter their license plate number, amount of time desired, and payment method.
  - A receipt is generated but it is not necessary to display the receipt on the car dashboard.
  - Meters available in the Center City Lot, Clinton North Lot, and Franklin & Liberty lot, as well as various locations for on-street parking


