2020 Hometown Heroes Banner Program Nomination Opportunity

The Downtown Schenectady Improvement Corporation (DSIC) and City of Schenectady are partnering for a sixth year on the popular **Hometown Heroes Banner Program**. This banner program proudly recognizes <u>active</u> <u>duty and veteran servicepersons</u>, <u>both living and deceased</u>. Each banner will honor a specific Schenectady serviceperson and will include his or her name, branch of service, and photo. Banners will be displayed on street lamps in Downtown Schenectady along State Street (from Veterans Park to South Church Street) and around City Hall from mid-May until mid-November.

<u>This program is to recognize Hometown Heroes throughout Schenectady County</u>, not just from the City of Schenectady. To qualify, honorees must meet at least the following requirements:

- One or more of the following: A) A current County resident; B) Born and raised in Schenectady County;
 C) graduated from one of Schenectady County's five (5) School Districts.
- 2. <u>Serving on active duty</u> in the United States Armed Forces or National Guard, OR a <u>military veteran</u> (living or deceased) who has served in the United States Armed Forces or National Guard and has been honorably discharged.

There is no cost to nominate a serviceperson; however, to guarantee that your honoree will be part of the banner program, you can choose to sponsor a banner. Banners may be sponsored by individuals or organizations, who are responsible for the full cost of the banner. Sponsorship support is essential to making this banner program a reality. The cost of sponsorship per banner is **\$300**. All of the banners will be located in the heart of downtown and will be seen by countless workers, residents, visitors and investors.

To process the nomination, please include:

- Proof of Schenectady County residency (past or present) and/or Schenectady County school district graduation for each honoree (e.g. copy of utility bill, driver's license, diploma).
- Verification of active duty status (e.g. copy of military orders or military ID)
- Verification of honorable discharge (e.g. copy of discharge papers/DD 214)
- High resolution digital photo, or 8x10 or 5x7 good quality photo (*Please provide a high resolution* portrait photo i.e. head and shoulders of the honoree in **uniform**. A digital image of at least 600 DPI is preferred, but we can scan 8x10 photos. All photos will be returned).
