GETTING TO DOWNTOWN SCHENECTADY





BY CAR

Downtown Schenectady is conveniently located along I-890, just off the New York State Thruway (I-90), and is just a short drive from New York City, Boston and Montreal.

- From South & East: Take NYS Thruway to Exit 25. Follow I-890 west to Exit 5 (Broadway - right at end of ramp), Exit 4C (Scotia - straight ahead or right onto Route 5 at end of ramp) or Exit 4B (Erie Boulevard - Bear left around curve to Erie Boulevard).
- From West: Take NYS Thruway to Exit 26. Follow I-890 east to Exit 4B (Erie Boulevard) or Exit 5 (Broadway - left at end of ramp).
- From North: Take I-87 to Exit 6 (Route 7 west). Turn right onto Route 7 west and follow for 9 miles to I-890 west. Follow I-890 west to Exit 5 (Broadway - right at end of ramp), Exit 4C (Scotia - straight ahead or right onto Route 5 at end of ramp) or Exit 4B (Erie Boulevard - Bear left around curve to Erie Boulevard)
